Jesus gave John and us a **divine outline and a table of contents** in the book of Revelation 1:19: *In Revelation 1:19 "Write the **things which you have seen**, and the **things which are**, and the **things which will take place after this**.*

- a. **Write the things which you have seen:** Glorified Christ in Chapter 1
- b. **Write the things which are;** the present experiences- the 7 Churches. Chapters 2/3
- c. **Write the things which will take place after this (After these things-meta-tauta): the future-** Finally, he was to introduce the events preceding, culminating in, and following the second coming of Christ (chaps. 4–22).

The 7 letters were written by Jesus:

1. To this seven specific church and thus **has a LOCAL application**,
2. But it is deeper than that; those seven messages are for all churches is **-ecclesiastically** "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the **churches.**"
3. There is also a third layer. There is **also a personal level.**

The church is a body of believers, that thus Christ is wanting to speak to each of us this morning.

4. Finally, there is also a 4th level-These seven messages also have a **historical-prophetical view: meaning that these seven churches represent** 7 eras/epics/ages of church history, chronologically, in order in totality.

In fact, by studying these letters you will see the **entire unfolding of church history.** church existing in the future.

Point #1 - Be on guard: It is easy to move to a relationship where love is replaced with legalistic rules; where passion is replaced with apathy; where grace is replaced by self-imposed growth.

Point #2 - In the midst of suffering and persecution, God is still on the throne and has a plan and a purpose.

Point #3 - Moral compromise with the world, leads to spiritual death!

Point #4 - Be sure your "traditions" point to God's Word, not to paganism.

Point #5 - Doctrines, such as faith through grace; sovereignty of God's Word, must be applied to our lives and result in knowing and trusting the Lord in a deeper way and loving Him greater.

Point #6 - God is not looking at our ability but at our availability to walk through doors of evangelistic opportunity in His power!

Point #7 - God wants us to live a life of an "Overcomer" through the power of His Holy Spirit working in our life!
